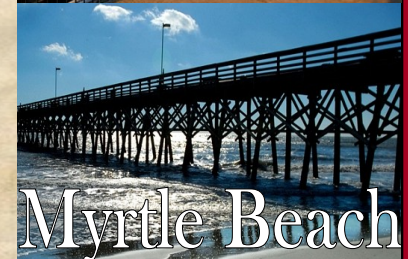

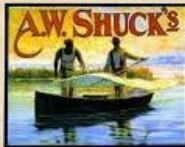
Tuesday, November 1st

We will leave the Conference Ministry Center early Tuesday morning for Charleston, SC. Upon arriving, we will check-in to the hotel and prepare to tour the city, Old Market, and traditional churches, followed by dinner.

After breakfast on Wednesday, we will be traveling to Liberty Square, a harbor area, where we will be taking a ferry boat to historic Fort Sumter, a national war monument. We will also adventure to Magnolia Plantation, the oldest tourist site in Charleston, where we will experience history and wildlife on the Nature Train. Dinner will be provided at AW Shucks seafood restaurant.

Thursday is also filled with exciting new adventures. We will depart from Charleston following breakfast for Savannah, GA. A guide will take us through historic Savannah, then to lunch and shopping on River Street which lines the Savannah River. We will then travel to Tybee Island for a leisurely visit of Tybee pier and coastline. Dinner will be provided at Mrs. Wilkes, an “Old-time, Family style dining” restaurant and local favorite.

Friday morning we will depart for Myrtle Beach, SC. After hotel check-in, we will shop at the Outlets, and later enjoy dinner at Bennett's Calabash Seafood Buffet. We will end the night with “The South's Grandest Christmas Show” at Alabama Theater, voted Myrtle Beach's #1 live attraction. We will return home Saturday morning following breakfast.
